

In the suit against John Kirkland I recovered the amount

commenced it being \$12.00 and costs of suit. Kirk-
land claimed the land under a deed from Ralph W.
Kirkland and not under ~~the~~ the will of R. He of
course refuses to pay any part of the legacy

testimony to justify commencing a suit at law
for the recovery of it. The remedy if any will
