

New Haven June 1. 1832. Whereas George Robinson, by
a quit-claims deed executed yesterday has conveyed to me all his right
title & interest, to a tract of land lying in Townsberg, Portage Co. Ohio,
— it being one undivided half of said tract, — for which said land I have
~~that~~ given him my note of hand for two hundred & fifty dollars of
the same date, — now therefore I do hereby agree & convey said land
& the said George or his heirs at demand, or to hold for his or their
own use the avails of said land, deducting therefrom the expenses which
may accrue thereon, & also the amount of my said note.
